Solidus Randy 250 is an analog simulation of the Randall[®] RG100ES (late '80s) and RH150 (late '00s) solid state amplifiers.

The RG100ES head, produced in the late 80s, has been a remarkable amplifier that defined the sound of some of the greatest metal bands of that time, while the RH150 is a more modern rendition with much more gain. Both amplifiers are renowned for their huge low end and crushing gain.

Once you install and open the plugin for the first time, it will be in **Demo Mode** until a license file is loaded. In Demo Mode the plugin will output 3 seconds of silence every minute.

You can activate the plugin either OFFLINE or ONLINE.

OFFLINE ACTIVATION

If you purchased the plugin from our site, you should have received an email to download the installers and the license file. Save the license file you got with your purchase email (or via our User Area) anywhere on your computer.

Then, to activate the plugin, click on the **Audiority** logo and select "**Register**". 



2) Once registered, log in to your account by clicking the User Area section of our site. Click the **REDEEM** section of your account and paste the code you received via email from our dealer.

TOOLBAR

The Toolbar allows you to manage the plugin presets, register the plugin and set some global parameters. Click the **AUDIORITY** logo, in the top left corner of the Toolbar, to visit our website and social profiles, register the plugin, change the interface size, switch between Bright/Dark modes and customize the paths for license and preset files. The **HQ** button will enable oversampling, useful to reduce aliasing when the signal saturates. Use the **Randomize** and **Reset** buttons to experiment with random presets or restoring it to its saved version. The **NOTIFICATIONS** (bell) icon will show you when a new update is available and other relevant news and offers.

IN / OUT	Adjust the volume of the signal before and after the chain.
EQ DUO / GATE / OD / AMP /	Left click: switch to the related effect page
OUT EQ / CAB	Right click: enable/disable the effect (same as the power switch)

RED / GREEN CHANNEL

GAIN	Adjust the amount of gain applied to the channel.
MASTER	Adjusts the main output volume of the channel.
PRESENCE / TREBLE / MIDDLE / BASS	Tone stack controls for the both channels.
REVERB	Adjust the amount of reverb added to the channel.
CH1 / CH2 SWITCH	Switch between the Clean (Green) and Overdrive (Red) channels.
CH2 SUSTAIN SWITCH	Enable an additional clipping stage, increasing the amount of distortion.
SWAP BUTTON	Switch between the RG and RH amplifier models.

CLEAN CHANNEL

LEVEL	Adjust the amount of gain applied to the channel.
REVERB	Adjust the amount of reverb added to the channel.
TREBLE / MIDDLE / BASS	Tone stack controls for the Clean channel
BOOST BUTTON	Doubles the amount of gain provided to the signal.

OVERDRIVE CHANNEL

GAIN 1 / GAIN 2	Adjust the amount of gain applied to Overdrive channel.
GAIN SELECT BUTTON	Switch between the two different gain sections.
TREBLE / MIDDLE / BASS	Tone stack controls for the Boost channel.
VOICING	Sets the MID center frequency to a lower value. Enable this to get a more scooped tone.
SWEEP	Adjusts the frequency of the MID tone stack filter. Setting this knob lower will produce stronger low mid-frequencies and turning the knob up will continue to move the mid-range to higher frequency. Start with a setting of 5,until you find your desired setting.

GLOBAL PARAMETERS

CH SELECT SWITCH	Switch between the Clean and Overdrive channels.
MASTER	Adjusts the main output volume of the amplifier

SWAP BUTTON POWER Switch between the RG and RH amplifier models. Sets the amplifier on/off.

PLUGIN PARAMETERS – EQ DUO PAGE



Clean boosters are basically a combination of tone shaping and amplification. We provided you a 6 band graphic equalizer followed by a 3 band parametric equalizer/booster.

6 BAND EQ PARAMETERS

- **FREQUENCY BANDS** Adjust the boost/cut of the selected band by +/- 20dB.
- **FOOT SWITCH** Sets both the EQ pedals on/off.

3 BAND PARAMETRIC EQ/BOOST PARAMETERS

INPUT GAIN	Adjust the incoming signal level from -Inf to +6dB.
FREQ	Adjust the center frequency of the selected band.
BW	Sets the bandwidth factor of the selected band.
GAIN	Adjust the cut/boost of the selected band from -Inf to +20dB.



TIP Use a combination of both EQs to shape and boost your DI guitar before hitting the amplifier. This is very useful when using the RG amp model.

PLUGIN PARAMETERS – NOISE GATE PAGE



A noise gate with frequency dependent sensitivity.

GATE PARAMETERS

- **TRIGGER LEVEL** Adjust the noise gate threshold.
- HISS / MID / FULLChange the gate frequency dependent sensitivity. Use Hiss for high frequency background
noise; Mid for noise coming from distortions and Full for more complex background noise.
- FOOT SWITCH Sets the gate on/off.

PLUGIN PARAMETERS – OVERDRIVE



Modern overdrive for every tone needs. Hybrid model based on the MXR Wylde Overdrive plus the Horizon Devices Precision Drive's Attack section.

OD PARAMETERS

LEVEL	Adjust the output volume of the pedal.
BRIGHT	Tone control. Move to the right to get a brighter tone or to the left to darken it.
ATTACK	Sets the bass response of the overdrive stage. Left is fuller and thick, while to the right is more modern and clear.
DRIVE	Sets the overdrive amount.
FOOT SWITCH	Sets the overdrive on/off.

A post-amp five band equalizer to shape the amp sound before going to the cabinet.

OUT EQ PARAMETERS

FREQUENCY BANDS	Adjust the boost/cut of the selected band by +/- 12dB.
INPUT / OUTPUT LEVEL	Sets the volume of the signal before and after the EQ.
FOOT SWITCH	Sets both the EQ on/off.
